The Dr. Bonnie Cameron Post-Secondary Scholarship – 2026

Purpose and Award

Established in 2013, The Dr. Bonnie Cameron Post-Secondary Scholarship exists to assist students living with arthritis in achieving their educational goals. It is presented by Runanthropic.org in honour of the inspiring work and dedication of Dr. Cameron and the entire Rheumatology staff at SickKids Hospital. The scholarship award is \$2,500.

Runanthropic was born out of the idea that as a community, runners thrive on helping others achieve their goals. Whether it be by sharing training tips, nutrition information, articles, websites, great races, or whatever! Runners also want to make a difference in their own communities. Raising money and awareness for the causes that are important to and inspire them. Runanthropic.org is the Runners' Philanthropy site.

Eligibility Requirements

This program is designed for applicants of any age entering or completing their first post-secondary degree. Applicants must be:

- A legal and permanent resident of Canada;
- First diagnosed with inflammatory arthritis by a physician prior to age 18;
- Entering, enrolled in, or awaiting acceptance to a Canadian post-secondary institution full-time for the fall semester of 2026;
- A student who demonstrates academic ambition and embraces a way of life that overcomes the restrictions of living with inflammatory arthritis; and
- Willing and able to comply with conditions outlined under Applicant Consent.

Scholarship committee members and their immediate family members are not eligible applicants.

The Selection of the Winner

The winner will be selected by the sole discretion of an independent committee and will be notified in the month of June by email. Should the winner be pending acceptance to a post-secondary program, the scholarship will be conditional on documentation of verification of enrolment in a post-secondary institution. The winner will receive a \$2,500 scholarship towards their post-secondary education.

Procedures

To apply, application must be submitted online no later than May 15, 2026. Each section of the application must be appropriately filled out by the applicant or designated professional. Along with the application forms, applicants must submit:

- A letter from the treating physician confirming the diagnosis;
- A one page letter of recommendation from a teacher, school official, professional colleague, employer or other member of the community who can attest to your activities (e.g. coach, volunteer coordinator, but not a family member);
- An official transcript from the applicant's most recent year of education;
- Verification of enrolment in a post-secondary institution for the fall semester of 2021; and
- A one page essay written by the applicant describing how they overcome the restrictions of their inflammatory arthritis.
